- Availability for volunteering one day a week for up to 1.5 hours throughout the school year
- Ability to adhere to Jeffco Public Schools mask/health mandates for school volunteers

#### **Volunteer Job Description - School Packer:**

School packers are responsible for filling sacks with kid-friendly food for distribution before the weekend. School packers work together at schools to separate bulk food items into individual sacks according to the menu provided. Volunteer school packers are an essential link in getting food to kids in need.
