What to Bring

Personal Information You Need

- **A copy of your 2019 and 2020 Federal Tax Return.** (May be required to determine Earned Income Credit Eligibility and Child Tax Credit).
- **Social Security Cards** for yourself, your spouse, and any dependents, if applicable.
- Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN), if applicable.
- **Government issued photo identification card** such as a driver's license.
- Identity Protection PIN (IP PIN), if the IRS has mailed one to you for identity theft.
- The total **amount received from Stimulus Payments in 2021**, or a copy of **IRS Notice 1444-C**. (If you did not receive the full Stimulus amounts, you may be eligible for a Recovery Rebate Credit.)
- **Bank account and routing number** for direct deposit (refund) or direct debit (payment).
- If you received Advance Child Tax Credit payments, bring the total amount of Advance Child Tax Credit payments received during 2021 or a copy of your **IRS letter 6419**. (IRS letter 6419 will be sent out by the IRS in early January 2022.)

Income

- All 2021 W-2 (Wage and Tax Statement) forms from all your employers. Your spouse's 2021 W-2 forms, if filing jointly.
- All Forms 1099 for you and your spouse (if filing jointly). The most common are:
 - 1099-MISC, miscellaneous income paid to you
 - 1099-NEC, nonemployee compensation
 - 1099-INT, showing interest paid to you
 - 1099-G, unemployment paid to you or any refund, credit or offset of state and local taxes paid to you
 - 1099-DIV and 1099-R, showing dividends and distributions from retirement and other plans paid to you
 - 1099-C, cancellation of debt
- Forms 1095-A (Health Insurance Marketplace Statement) if you have health insurance through the Marketplace.
- If self-employed, in addition to your 1099-NEC income document(s), download and bring a completed Self-Employment Tax Organizer to show your expenses and business miles.

Expenses and Other Forms

- Any Form 1098-T educational expenses paid to a qualified educational institution (including tuition/mandatory fees and interest paid on student loans).
- If you may be able to Itemize your deductions, bring receipts of your expenses for out-of-pocket medical and dental, property taxes, auto vehicle registration, home mortgage interest, charitable contributions, casualty losses, and other job expenses.
- If you pay a child care provider, the address and Tax ID numbers of the provider(s) (Social Security or Federal ID numbers).
- If you are Amending your tax return, a copy of the **original return** submitted and any of the above documents that you are correcting.
