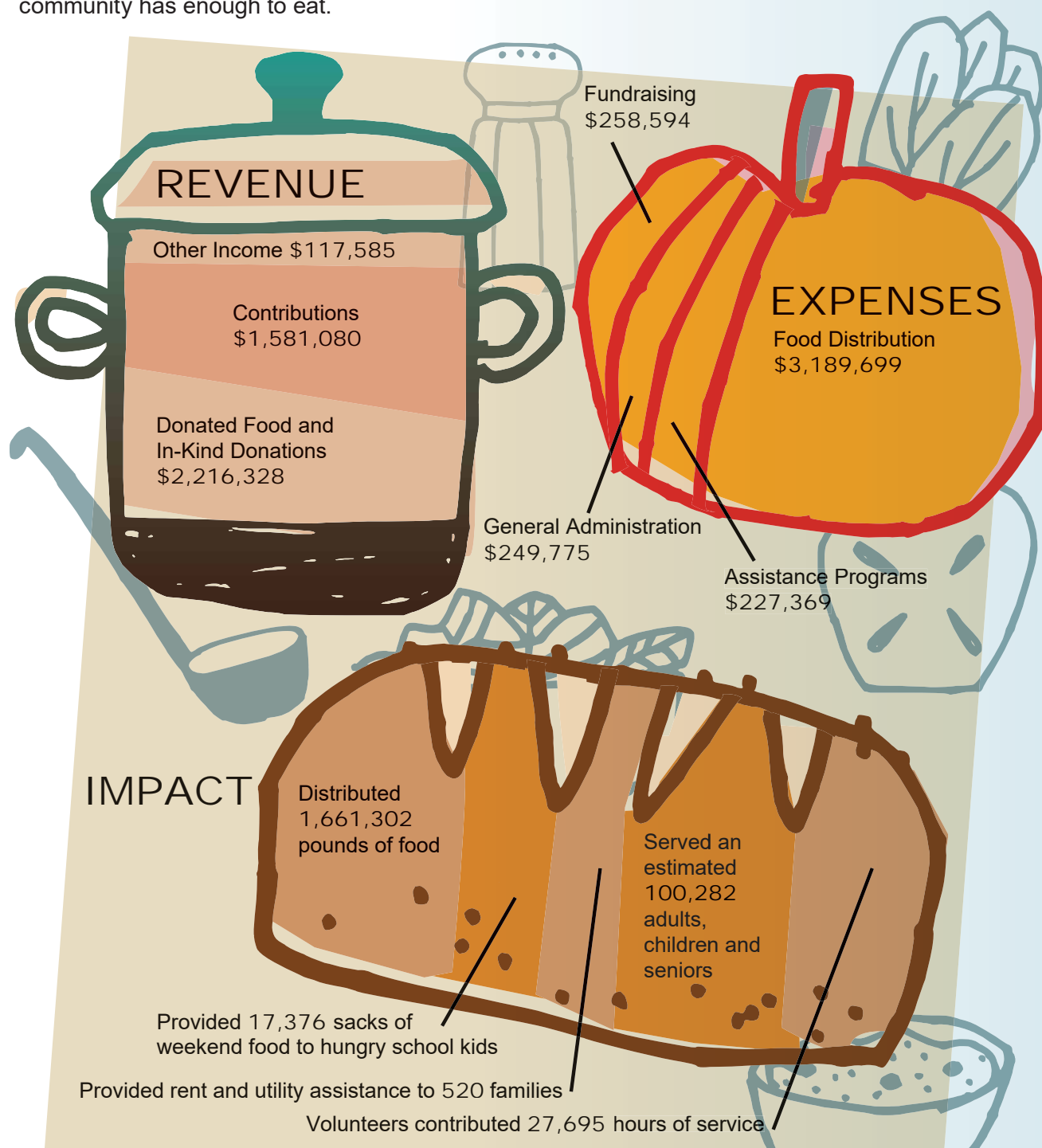


2023 Annual Impact Report
